Understanding the Mass

**The Introductory Rites:
The Kyrie, the Gloria and the Collect**



The Penitential Rite and Kyrie Eleison

The Penitential Act is part of the Introductory Rites as Mass. It follows the greeting. At the very beginning of the Mass, the faithful recall their sins and place their trust in God's abiding mercy. The Penitential Rite includes the Kyrie Eleison, a Greek phrase meaning, "Lord, have mercy." This litany recalls God's merciful actions throughout history. On Sundays, especially in Easter Time, in place of the customary Penitential Act, from time to time the blessing and sprinkling of water to recall Baptism may take place. On Sundays, solemnities, and feasts, the Gloria follows the Penitential Act.

The Gloria

One of the most beautiful prayers in the Mass is the Gloria. Monks chant it. Composers today, like Vivaldi and Bach in the past, set it to music. The Gloria begins by echoing the proclamation of the angels at the birth of Christ: "Glory to God in the highest!" In this ancient hymn, the gathered assembly joins the heavenly choirs in offering praise and adoration to the Father and Jesus through the Holy Spirit. During the seasons of Advent and Lent, the Gloria is not sung at mass. We sing the Gloria because it is a song of absolute joy and praise to God – what better way to start the Mass then to glorify God!

The Collect

The Introductory Rites conclude with an opening prayer, called the Collect. The celebrant invites the gathered assembly to pray and, after a brief silence, proclaims the prayer of the day. The Collect gathers the prayers of all into one and disposes all to hear the Word of God in the context of the celebration.



GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

November 6, 2022

32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Facing her 50th birthday and recently diagnosed with Type-2 Diabetes, Rebecca was at a crossroads. Realizing that she had neglected her health and fitness over the years and allowed herself to gain significant weight, she felt poorly about who she had become. While it was easier to give in to temptation and the gratification received from food, her family needed her, and she desired a long life. She had an image of the person she could become. She wanted to be more trim, focused, disciplined, and healthy. She liked what she saw in her mind and set out on a journey to create it. With great effort, she succeeded and accomplished her goals. When we have a goal ahead of us, we are more apt to do whatever is necessary to get it.

Is heaven a goal you want to achieve? Our popular images and metaphors to describe heaven can leave some people wondering if this is something they want for all eternity. Living like an angel, wearing white robes, meeting St. Peter, and reconnecting with loved ones are all welcome notions to some extent. But do they really inspire and captivate us enough to want to dramatically change how we live our lives? Heaven's reality is more profound than any human image or idea can fathom. Even though we believe in a bodily resurrection, heaven is more about attaining union with God. To achieve heaven is to attain eternal happiness and fulfill all desire. How do we awaken within us an ardent and passionate desire for heaven?

St. Isaac of Ninevah counsels, "Enter eagerly into the treasure house that lies within you, and so you will see the treasure house of heaven, for the two are one and the same, and there is but one single entry into them both. The ladder that leads to the kingdom is hidden with you, and is found in your own soul. Dive into yourself and in your soul you will discover the rungs by which to ascend." Our souls are made to be eternal. Once we discover our true selves and are captivated by the wonder of who we really are, we will unleash our unwavering desire for a lasting union with our Creator. Heaven is about who we are. "For seeing you, our God, as you are, we shall be like you for all the ages."

Accompanied to faith by the Bread of Life

Supper at Emmaus, Rembrandt van Rijn, 1648, Louvre

In the days after Jesus' crucifixion his disciples were left shaken and doubtful. The risen Jesus' appearances move the disciples from fear to hope, and from doubt to faith. A pivotal moment in their Easter faith experience was the journey to and supper at Emmaus as Jesus walked with them, listened to their concerns, and explained the meaning of all of Scripture. The disciples did not recognize Jesus until they rested that evening. Then, as Jesus broke bread at table, their eyes were opened and they recognized him in the breaking of bread.

Rembrandt, the master Dutch painter of the 17th century, captures in this remarkable etching that dramatic spiritual moment when Jesus breaks bread and the disciples first see the Lord with eyes of faith. The small, ordinary room holds four figures — Jesus, two disciples and a table attendant — crowded around a simple table covered with cloth. The bare stone evokes the simplicity of the scene as the arched wall frames the figure of Jesus seated at the table with disciples who had begged him to stay with them.

Jesus blesses bread at the center of the scene as warm golden light radiates from his face and illuminates his hands. The disciples now look intently at Jesus with eyes of faith and love. Lines of radiating light from Jesus' face illuminate the disciples' hearts, who are transformed as they say to one another, "Were not our hearts burning as he spoke to us?" Rembrandt invites us to take our place at this table of blessing so we too may see with eyes of faith that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharistic breaking of bread.
