UNDERSTANDING THE DIACONATE

Like bishops and priests, deacons are **ordained ministers of the Catholic Church** and share Christ's mission and grace.

CHARACTERISTICS OF A DEACON

- A deacon is a man **deeply attentive to the Scriptures** as an ongoing encounter with Jesus.
- He **loves the Church** and expresses a willingness to abide by doctrines and morals.
- He **exhibits a desire to evangelize** and publicly proclaim his love of Christ and the Church.



MINISTRIES OF A DEACON

- **Minister of the Word:** deacons proclaim the Gospel, preach and teach in the name of the Church
- **Minister of Sacrament:** deacons baptize, lead the faithful in prayer, witness marriages and conduct wake and funeral services
- **Minister of Charity:** deacons are leaders in identifying the needs of others

The Diocese of Joliet has begun the process of inviting men to discern the call to the diaconate through a number of informational sessions:

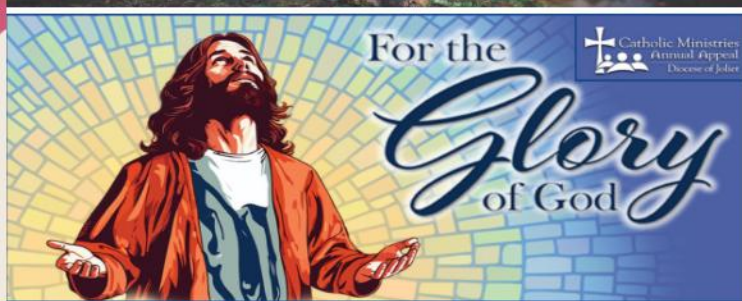
