Guidelines for Wedding Photographers

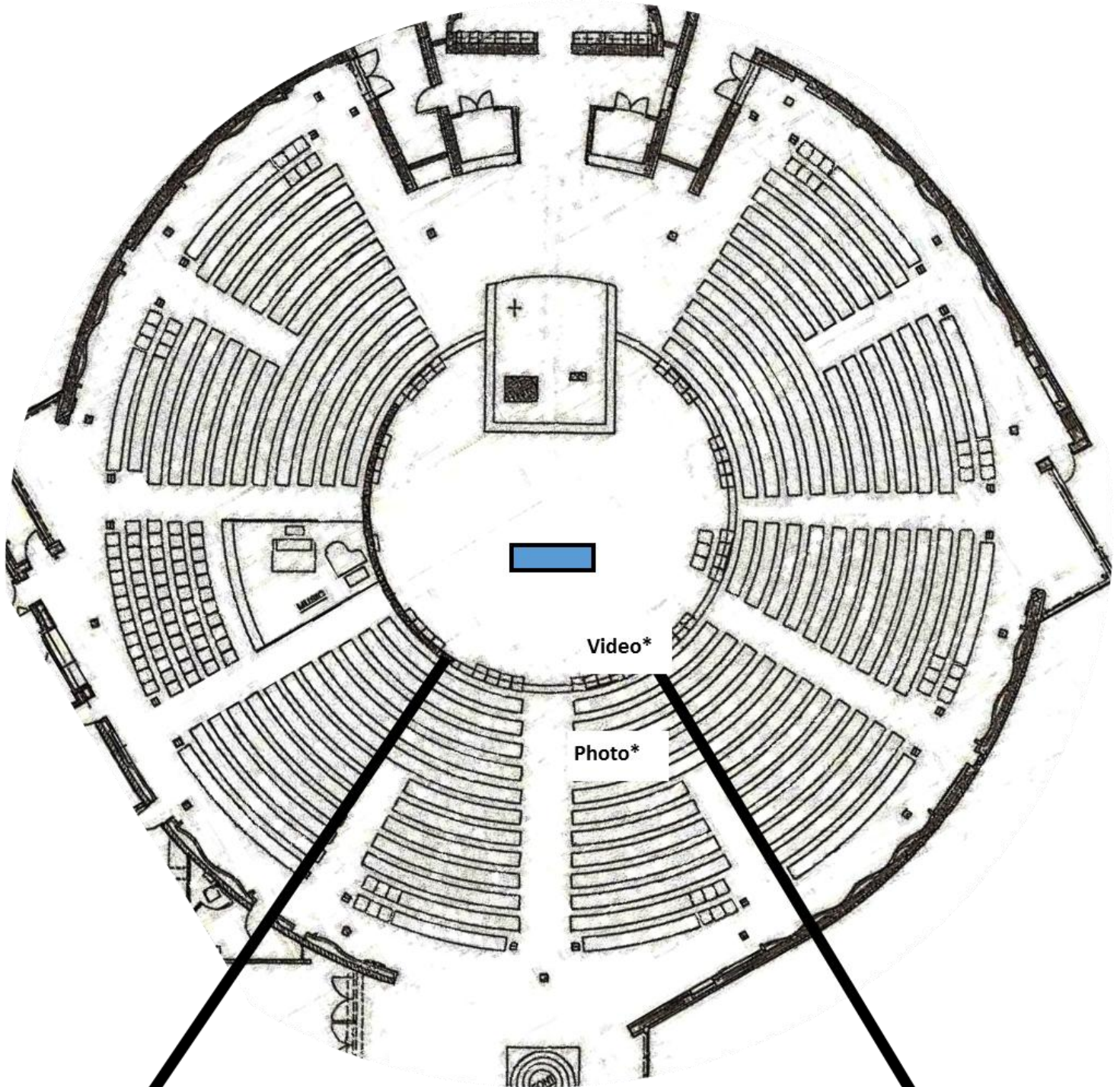
We welcome you to Holy Spirit Catholic Church as you provide your services during the Sacrament of Marriage in our Church.

So that you may effectively provide the wedding couple with the service they desire at their sacred union, please follow the following policy.

- Cameras and/or video cameras are not allowed on or behind the altar platform.
- Remote/Unmanned Video cameras on a tripod in a fixed position off the altar platform are allowed.
- **Please, NO flash photography during the liturgy**, only available lighting is to be used.
- Picture taking is allowed **after** the wedding liturgy, providing all is concluded within a half hour after the ceremony. You must be finished up by 3:25pm on Saturdays.
- No flash umbrellas or other picture station devices may be used at any time.
- A diagram of our Worship Space is on the back of this page. The area outlined in bold lines indicates areas where cameras and/or videos are **NOT** allowed.
- The wedding hostesses will direct photographers. Please ask them when you arrive if you have questions.

***During Procession*:** Photographers may stand in the center aisle at the marked places during the procession only. Once the procession is finished, you must go to the back area of the worship space.

During Ceremony/Mass: All photos/videos must be taken between these lines. You may enter the half-aisles, but do not enter the carpeted area of the center aisle once the procession is complete.
